Each family is asked to bring in a dozen cookies, bars or treats of some kind. If possible, please avoid treats that contain nuts as we have students with severe allergic reactions. We want this to be a safe evening for everyone.

Preschool students are not part of this program but families are welcome to come to either performance.

- Many students dress up for the evening performance. This is not required but if your child wants to that is fine. The daytime performance is usually more casual because they are having a regular school day up to the show time.
- Treats can be brought to the school office Monday or Tuesday during the day or to the gym the night of the performance. Having them on disposable plates or containers works best.
- All families are asked to enter through the main church doors. Students will be allowed into the school (including the gym) AFTER 6:10pm. If you come before this, wait in the church with your child. Please be respectful of the church environment. There is a lot of excitement on this evening but running or chasing in the church or gathering area is never appropriate.
- After the 1:30 performance if you want to take your child home with you please talk to their teacher before taking them. After the 6:30 performance, you are free to leave with your child whenever you are ready. Remember to grab coats out of lockers if needed.
