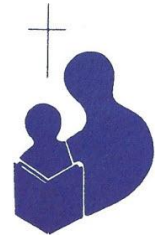

What is the Annual Home & School Meeting? Hand Foot and Mouth Disease (HFMD) is going through the community. Here are some things to know about HFMD from our school nurse... HFMD is transmitted through physical contact, coughing or sneezing, and saliva or mucus (like sharing cups.....) with those infected. You can be infected and transmitting the virus days before you have symptoms. Symptoms include; fever, sore throat, irritability, loss of appetite, general feelings of being unwell, some may develop red spots or blisters on hands, feet or buttocks, or mouth. Staying hydrated is important. HFMD usually runs its course within 10 days. Kids or adults can return to work or school when fever is gone for 24 hours and blisters or sores are healed (no blisters or mouth sores present).

OLV Church is hosting a flu shot clinic tomorrow, Thursday, Oct 11 from 9:30-11:00. Anyone interested in getting a flu shot should bring their insurance card to the Fellowship Hall. Children need a parent with them to receive the immunization.

Marathon money needs to be turned in tomorrow so we can get a final count. Thank you to all those that joined us last Friday and a big thank you to Fr. Jeremy for leading us in our decade of the rosary to close out the day.
