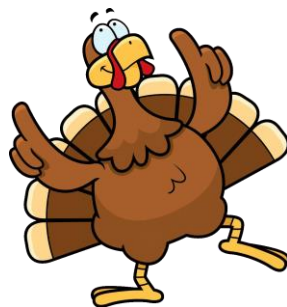

We are seeing a good response from families that are using the National Scrip Program. They have some smaller amount cards now through mid-December for the Christmas season. There have been 912 cards (or ecards) ordered through the National Program, generating \$945 of profit for the school. This isn't even counting the Local Cards program that continues to be used. There are some families that have earned their \$100 in profit already! This is great news. We can look at how this fundraiser could help families reduce their tuition responsibility. The cold weather is here and students are excited for more snow to play in. Please send warm snow clothing to school with your child EVERY DAY! Many students have 2 pairs of mittens so they can wear one during their morning recess and a dry pair at lunch recess (and even a third pair for Kids Club). Winter boots keep students feet warm and dry; please do not send fuzzy, casual boots that are not meant for playing in the snow. These get very wet and then feet get cold! We go outside to play as much as we can. We use a wind chill chart from the National Weather Service to determine if we go outside or stay in at recess. If you need help with warm winter clothing please contact the school office.

All students K-6 have their own account on iXL. This is a website that works on Math and Reading skills separated by grade level. The great part is students can go back and work on skills they need more practice with, even if it is at a lower grade level or work on future skills by working in higher grade levels. There is good math fact practice for both addition and multiplication that students can use to practice regardless of their grade. Check out this resource that is provided by the school for your child to use. Most students have their login in their student planner. If it is not there, contact your child's teacher for it.
