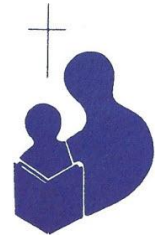

**The cold weather is here** and students are excited for more snow to play in. Please send warm snow clothing to school with your child EVERY DAY! Many students have 2 pairs of mittens so they can wear one during their morning recess and a dry pair at lunch recess (and even a third pair for Kids Club). Winter boots keep students feet warm and dry; please do not send fuzzy, casual boots that are not meant for playing in the snow. These get very wet and then feet get cold! We go outside to play as much as we can. We use a wind chill chart from the National Weather Service to determine if we go outside or stay in at recess. If you need help with warm winter clothing please contact the school office.
