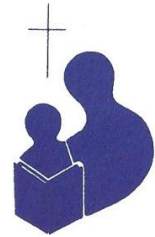

**OLV School Marathon** – School Marathon for Grades K-6 is scheduled for Friday, October 5<sup>th</sup> from 1-2 pm. This is an annual fundraiser for non-public education. Students are asked to get pledges/donations for each lap or a flat amount. Students bike or walk around the school with the four street corners blocked off. The Knights of Columbus will be helping with safety at the corners. There is one pledge sheet per family...if you need another, please call the school office. Each student is asked to raise \$100 or get 5 pledges. Grandparents, neighbors, alumni families and parishioners are all great people to ask to pledge. Pledge money can be turned into the office any time before Tuesday, October 9<sup>th</sup>.

For each pledge collected, the student's name will be put in a drawing for Scholastic Book Fair dollars.

**Throughout the school year** you will see 4 main fundraisers. They are the Marathon, Wreath Sales, Kids Heart Challenge (formerly Jump rope or Hoops for Heart), and the Spring Gala. The marathon and wreath sales both fall in September/October, Kids Heart Challenge is usually in January and the Spring Gala is the Saturday after Easter (so early to late spring). Money raised for the marathon helps fund the general operating budget of the school. Wreath sales profits help Home & School provide extras to the school and provide the School Spring Play. Kids Heart Challenge is put on through the American Heart Association and the school gets money for Phy Ed equipment based on the funds raised. And finally the Spring Gala. The money raised during this largest fundraiser helps fund the school, support teacher wages, buy books and keep tuition affordable. You will hear more about these different fund raising efforts as the year goes on.
