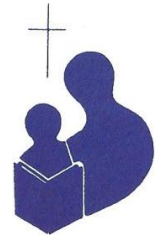

Food Shelf Donations will be taken to the Community Food Shelf tomorrow (January 3rd) by our 5th graders. While there, students will learn how our donations are processed and distributed.

Kids Heart Challenge (formerly Jump Rope for Heart)....will begin January 7th and runs through January 25th. Information packets will be sent home January 7th with your students. The first day to turn in donations for prizes will be January 8th.

Daily Recess – We follow the guideline for wind chill put out by the National Weather Service. Students go outside for a 15 minute recess every day if possible. Please send warm, dry clothing every day...make sure your child has boots, a hat, and warm gloves.

MAP Testing.....January 10th - 25th. Students test for a max of 45 minutes on their testing days. Kindergarten – 2nd grade take a math and reading test, while 3rd – 6th take math, reading & ELA (English, Language Arts). Students can take as much time as they need to complete these tests, but most students finish in 1-2 testing sessions per subject.

WITNER WEATHER/SCHOOL CLOSING.....OLV School follows the public school with late starts and weather related closings. Please sign up for OLV's Remind Texts if you have not already done so. We try to get this information on our school website as soon as possible.....just note that if you hear public school is starting late or closed due to weather, so is OLV. There is no morning Kids Club on days with late starts and no afterschool kids club on days with early closing.

During the winter months we continue to get students outside to play as much as possible, following the Wind Chill Index chart. Along with winter play comes warm hats, and warm hats can mean lice. Encourage your student to not share hats with others, check their hair weekly for signs of lice and use natural sprays to help deter lice. Lice love clean hair but we are not suggesting you stop washing! Just be watchful for them.

DO NOT send your child to school if:

- Temp of 100 or higher (can return once fever free for 24 hrs)
- Vomiting within the past 24 hrs
- Diarrhea within the past 24 hrs
- Body rash with itching or fever
- Head Lice
- Eye Infection (redness, itching and/or pus drainage from eye)
