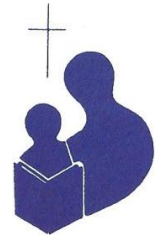

Home and School organizes bi-monthly teacher treats for staff. They have created a sign up through Meal Train to make it accessible for all families to sign up. You can access the sign up by typing <https://mealtrain.com/k7vo2d> into your search bar, by clicking on the link that will be sent out through a Remind text, or by going to the OLV website and following the link there. There is a sign up spot for the beginning of the month and the middle of the month. Treats can be dropped off in the school office or the teacher's lounge. If you have any questions about this teacher appreciation gesture, please contact a Home and School board member or if you are a new family, contact your mentor parent.

All students in grades K-6th are invited to a 4-H Project Day at Underwood School on Saturday, January 19th. Registration is from 8:15-9 and the cost is \$7 per student. Participants do NOT have to be a 4-H member. More information is on our website. There will not be a January Afterschool 4-H meeting at OLV, students are encouraged to come to Project Day.

MAP Testing.....January 10th - 25th. Students test for a max of 45 minutes on their testing days. Kindergarten – 2nd grade take a math and reading test, while 3rd – 6th take math, reading & ELA (English, Language Arts). Students can take as much time as they need to complete these tests, but most students finish in 1-2 testing sessions per subject.

Catholic Schools Week (CSW) will start Sunday, January 27 with a kick-off mass at 10:30, followed by the Carnival from 11-1:30. New this year, families can order their Carnival packages beforehand by sending in an order form to the office. These preordered packages will be available at a will call table the day of the Carnival. Payment will be made at the will call table. This order form is in your family envelope today. We hope this will cut down on waiting in line to purchase tickets. Tickets will still be available for purchase the day of the carnival as well. Watch for more information about this.

CSW field trip permission slips are in your envelop today. Please read these carefully and return them to school. Andes tubing and skiing is the only field trip parents are asked to pay for. Also, if you want your child to have a rental helmet, parents need to pay for this also. Money can be sent to school at anytime before January 23rd. Rental slips for skis and helmets will come home next week for students needing them. SkyZone requires an online waiver for each student but these are good for one year. If SkyZone does not have a waiver on file for your child you will have a separate sheet in your envelop letting you know how to complete the waiver and which of your children need it. Most returning students already have a SkyZone waiver on file with them (we went on 2/3/18 last year).
